No. 10/51/2017-1T2/1325 In exercise of the powers conferred by rule 42-A of the Punjab Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to supersede the notification no. 10/51/2017-1T2/1296 dated 14.10.2021 issued by Government of Punjab, Department of Transport (Transport-II Branch) namely:-

AMENDMENT

1. In the said notification, under the heading the process of e-auction, after serial no. 21, the following entry shall be inserted, namely:-

22. An amount of Rs.25,000/- (Rs. Twenty five thousand only) as earnest money deposit (EMD), is required to be deposited by the applicant to bid for the reserved registration marks namely 0001 to 0009 and 0786 along with the non-refundable registration charges already notified. If the applicant is successful in the bidding, then EMD will be adjusted against the bidding amount which will be required to be deposited by the successful bidder within the stipulated period already notified. In case the highest bidder does not deposit the amount within the stipulated period, EMD of Rs.25,000/ (Rs. Twenty five thousand only) will be forfeited. The EMD will be refunded automatically to the unsuccessful bidders through the Vahan Portal managed by the NIC to the account from where the amount was received.

2. This notification will come into force w.e.f. 31.10.2021.


